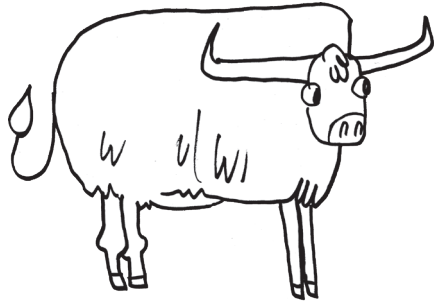


Abraham

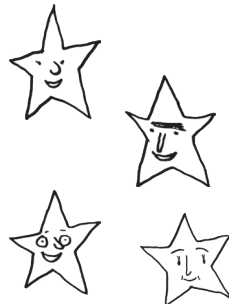
Take a Look

Here are some of the people and things in today's story. What can your child tell you about them?
